

BLUE LIGHT SALES

In the interest of public safety and an effort to prevent the potential abuse of emergency lights used by law enforcement agencies, the Arkansas State Police has been given the responsibility of regulating the sale or transfer of the lights.

§ 5-77-301. Blue light sales.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to sell or transfer a blue light to any person other than a certified law enforcement officer. The sale or transfer shall be reported to the Department of Arkansas State Police on a form prescribed by the department.
- (b) A violation of this section shall be a Class A misdemeanor.
- (c) As used in this section, "blue light" means an operable blue light which:
 - (1) Is designed for use by an emergency vehicle, or is similar in appearance to a blue light designed for use by an emergency vehicle; and
 - (2) Can be operated by use of the vehicle's battery, the vehicle's electrical system, or a dry cell battery.
