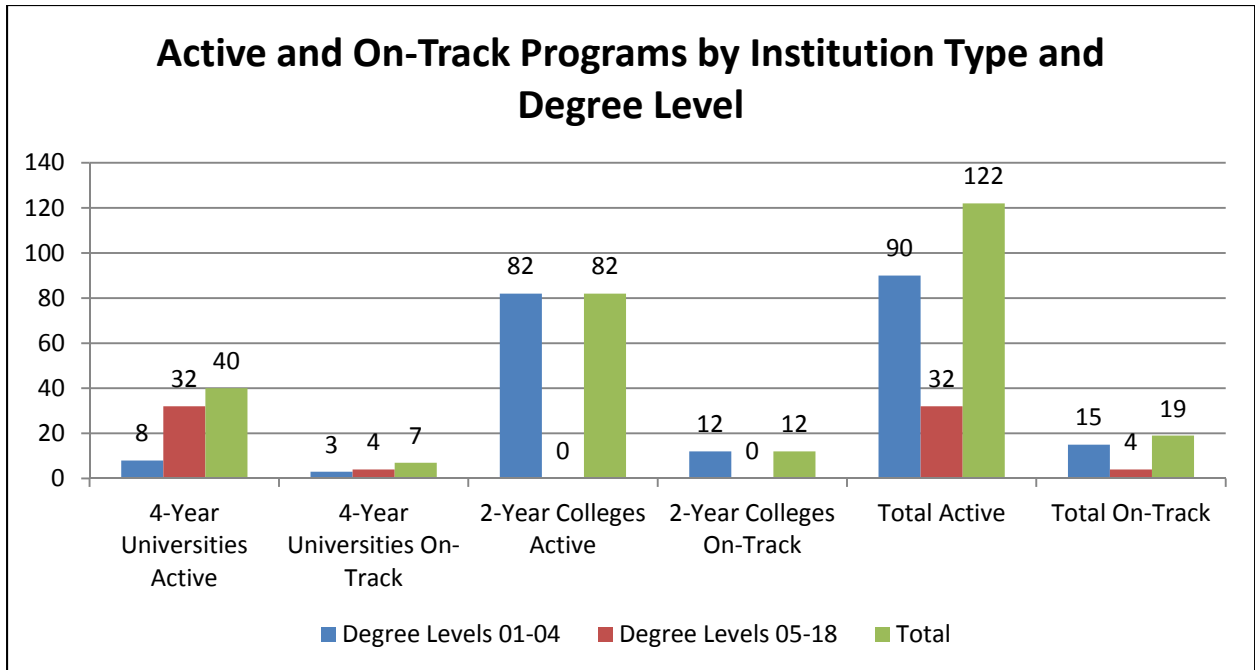

This agenda item summarizes degree productivity for:

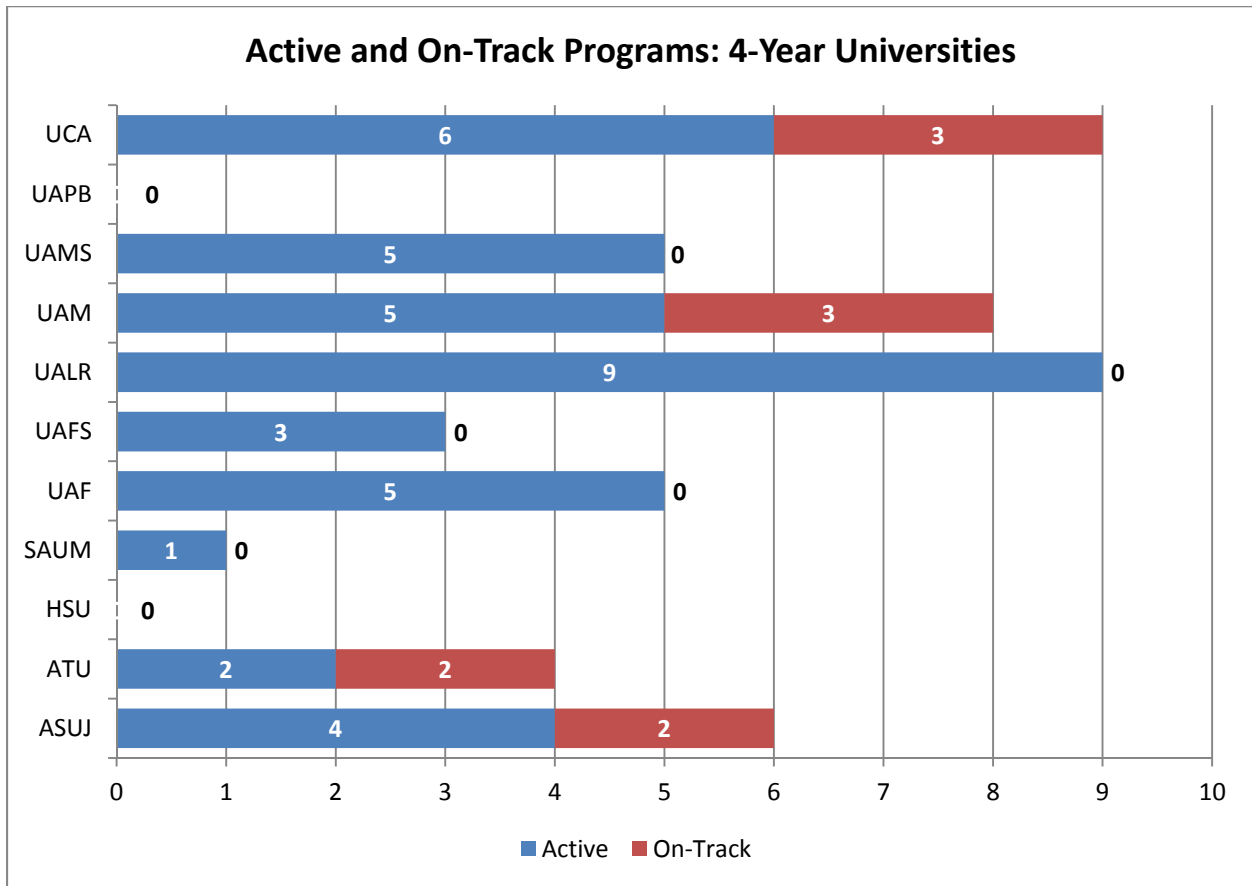
- Baccalaureate and Graduate programs approved between July 1, 2005 and June 30, 2006 (Academic Year 2006); and
- Associate and Certificate programs approved between July 1, 2007 and June 30, 2008 (Academic Year 2008).

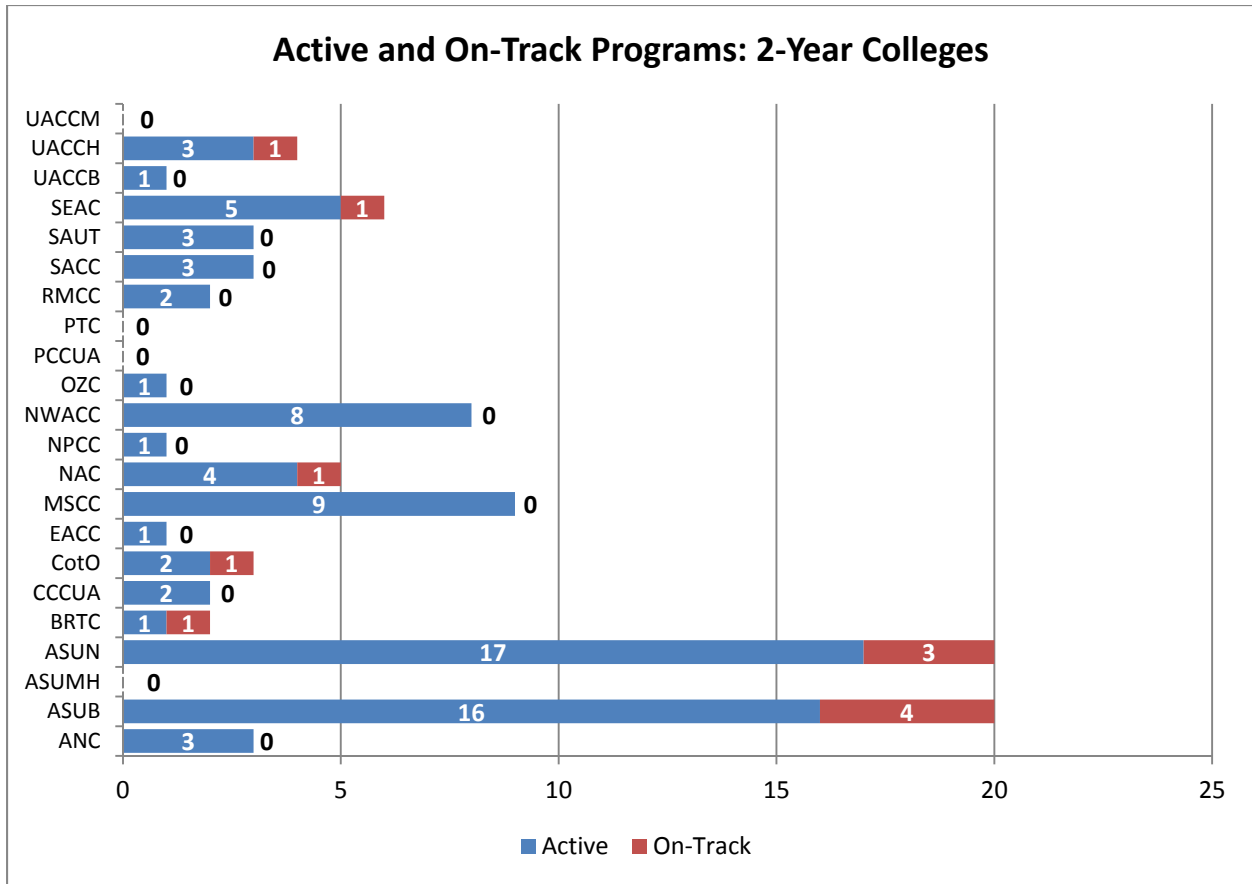
The table below summarizes the total number of new programs remaining active and identifies their productivity performance as being on track to meet viability standards.

Because programs need time to develop and produce graduates, productivity for certificate and associate programs are measured **three years** after approval, while baccalaureate and higher programs are measured **five years** after approval.
