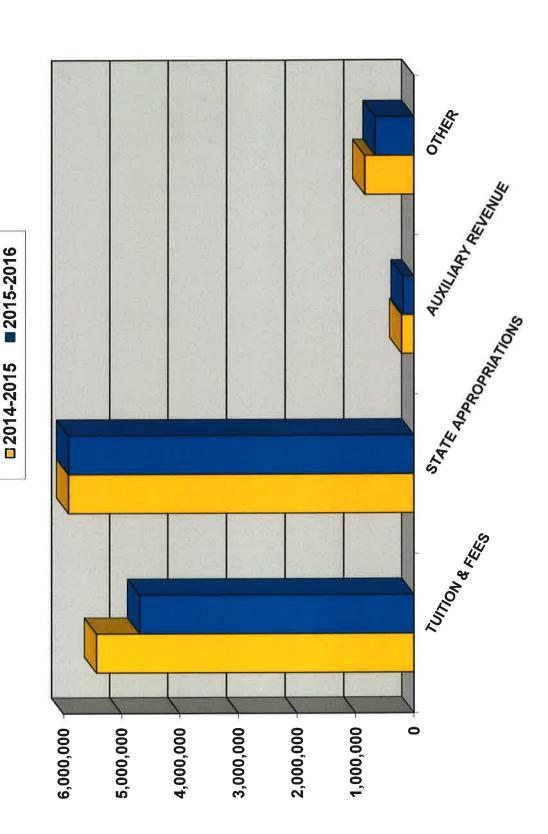

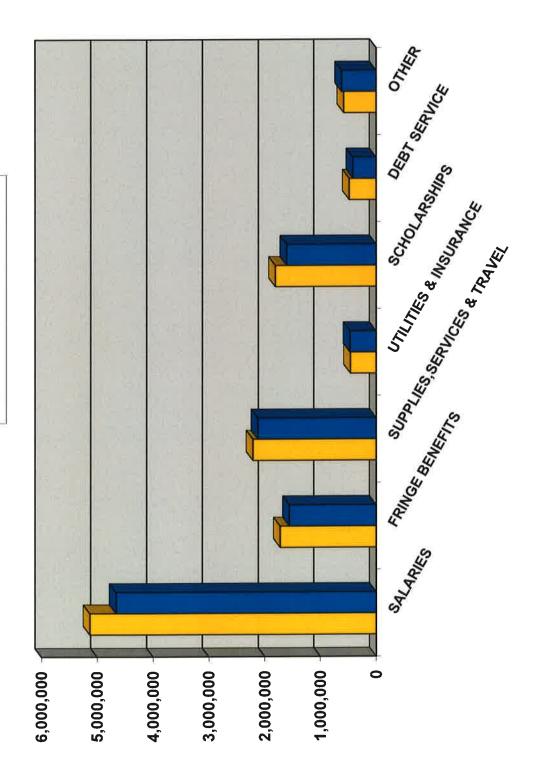

FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2016





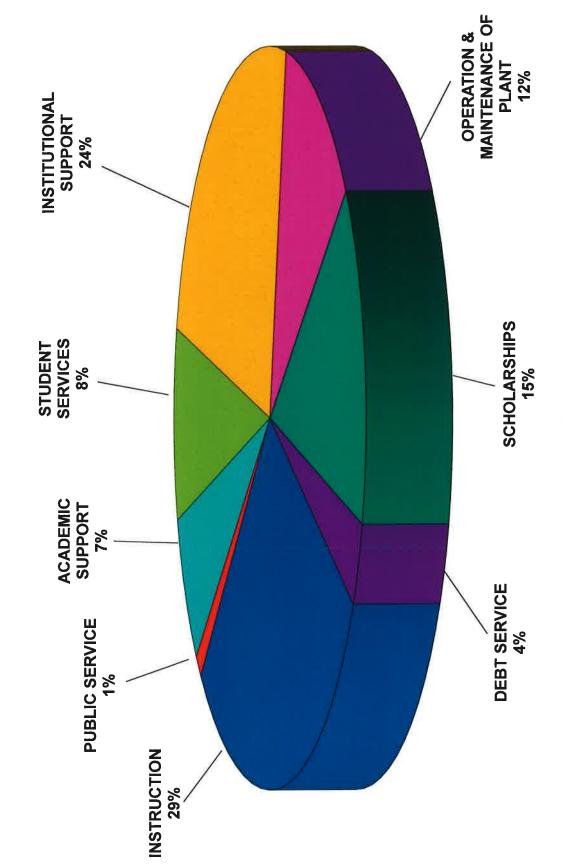

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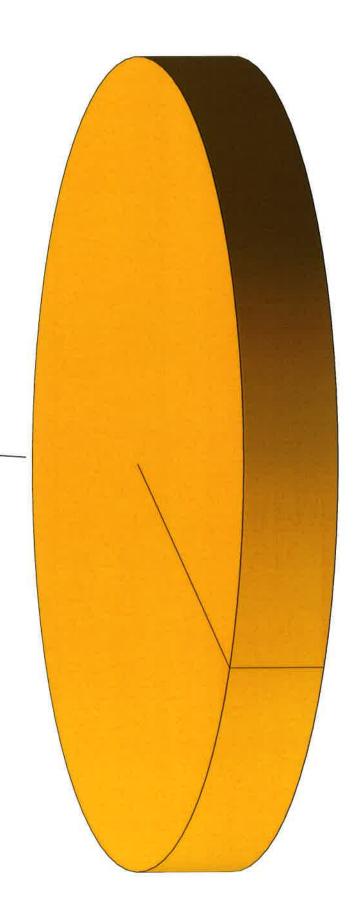

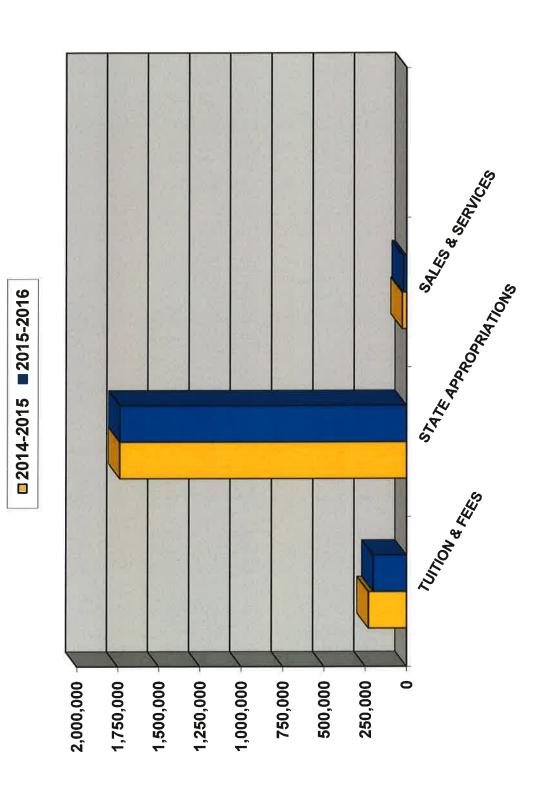

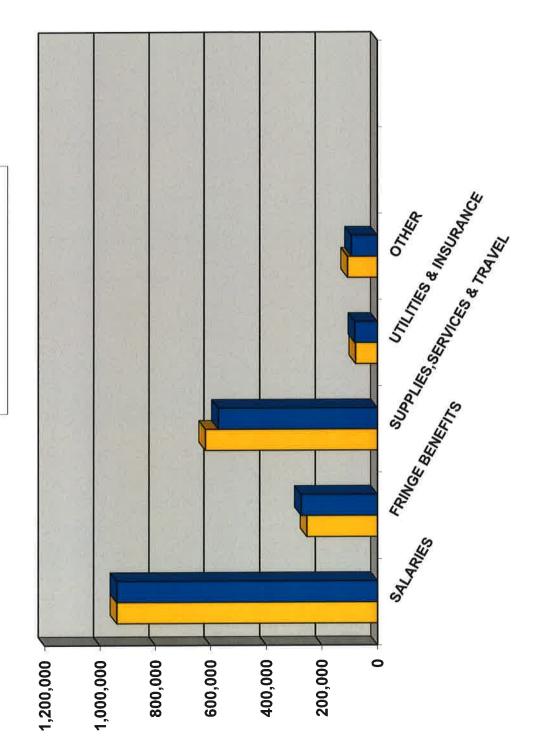

FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2016





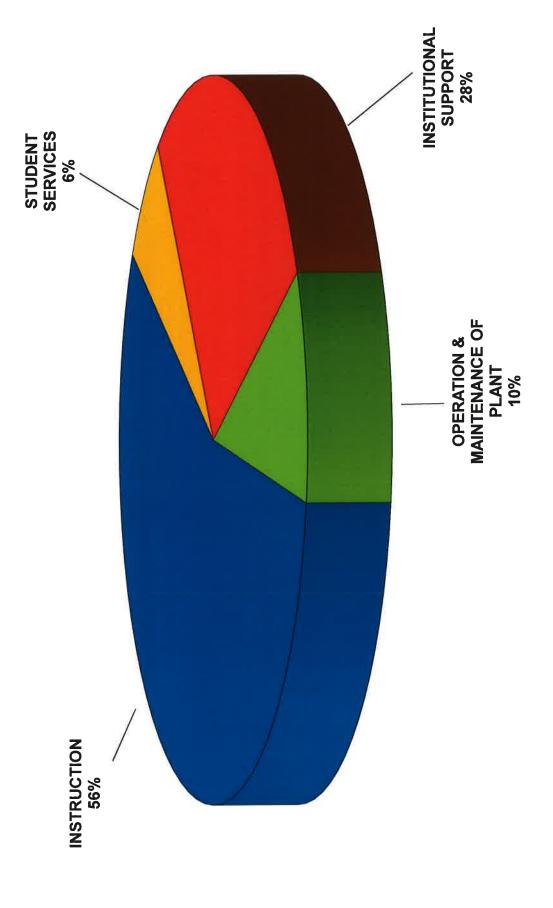

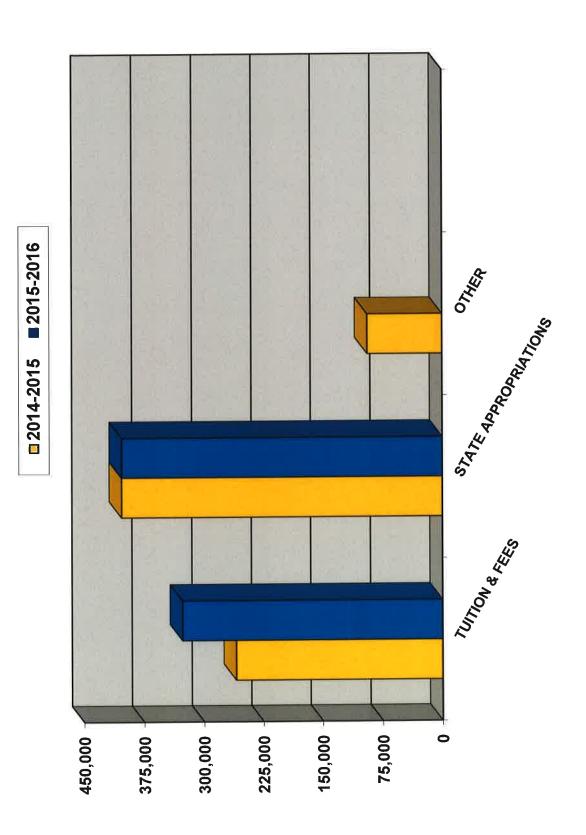

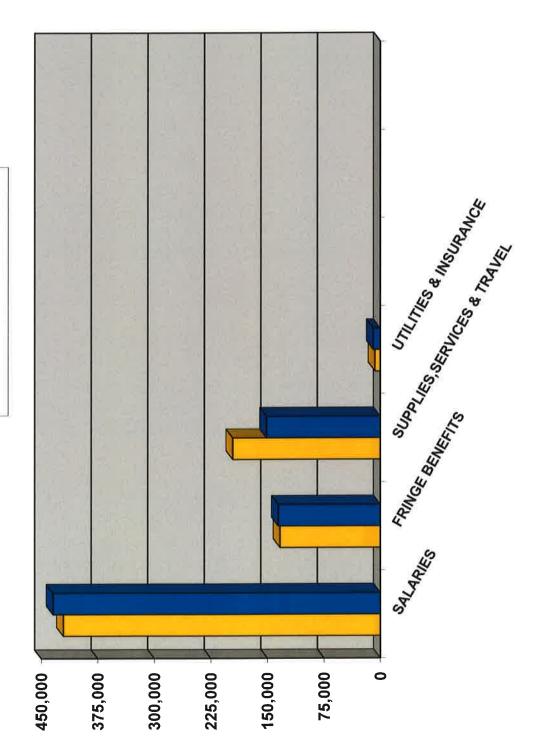

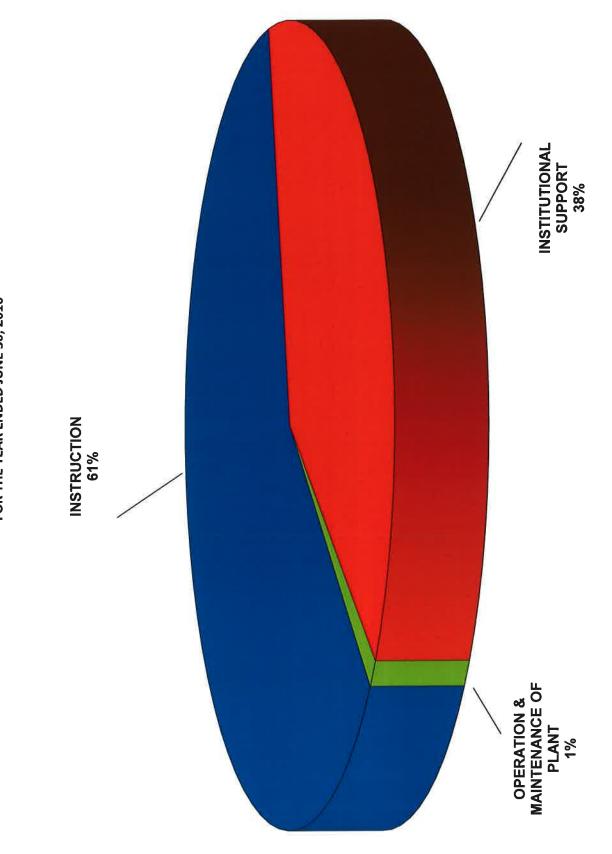

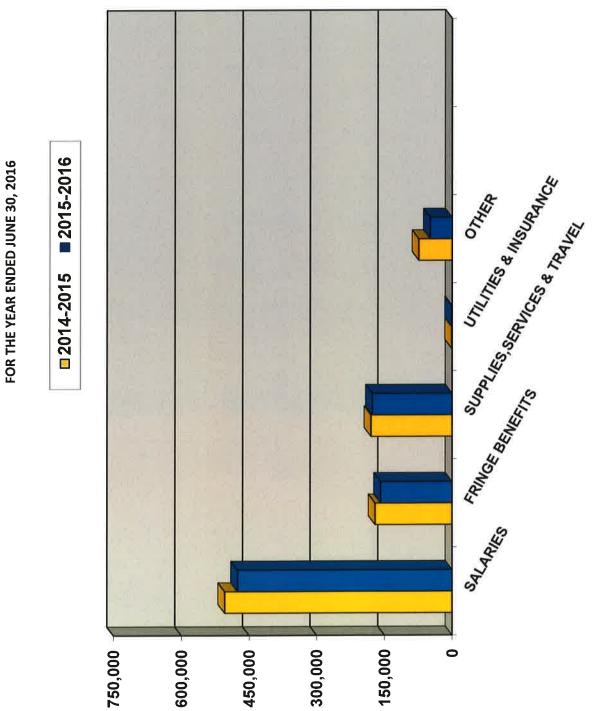

FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2016



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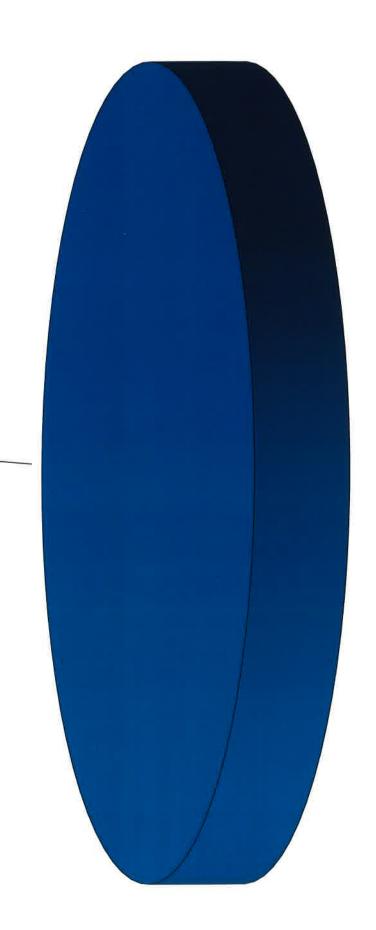
