

Marriage License

Both parties must be present with social security card AND valid State issued ID, passport OR birth certificate. All forms of ID must be in English. If a party does not have a copy of their social security card, contact your nearest Social Security office for a confirmation letter.

There is no waiting period required in Arkansas. License may be issued immediately if the applicants are both age 18 or over. Males age 17 and females age 16 or 17 must fulfill a mandatory waiting period of 5 business days. Parental consent is required. If divorced, the parent with full custody must give consent.

No medical or blood tests are required in Arkansas.

The fee is \$60.20 certified copies are provided when married. Additional copies \$5 each.

Applicants 18 and 19 years of age *must also provide* a copy of their birth certificate.

Covenant Marriage License

In order to have a Covenant Marriage License issued, which is optional, you must go through several months of counseling by a minister, priest, rabbi clerk of the Society of Friends, any clergy member of any religious sect, a licensed professional counselor, psychologist or licensed associate marriage and family therapist.
