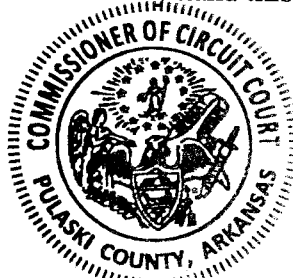
Little Rock, Arkansas, upon a credit of three months, the following described property situated in Pulaski County, Arkansas, to-wit:

Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Block 11, Ruebel & Leymer's Addition to the City of Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas, and the East 1/2 of the closed alley which adjoins Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Block 11, Ruebel & Leymer's Addition, which alley was closed by Ordinance No. 16,596, in the City of Little Rock, TOGETHER with all right, title, and interest of the Grantor under that certain Private Road Easement dated April 28, 1995, between William H. Buddenberg, Jr. and the Trustees of Fairview Baptist Church, filed May 4, 1995, as Instrument Number 95-25043, in the real property records of the Circuit Clerk and Ex-Officio Recorder of Pulaski County, Arkansas, LESS AND EXCEPT the lands conveyed to the City of Little Rock, by a Quitclaim Deed Filed August 6, 1998, as Instrument Number 98060515, records of Pulaski County, Arkansas.
