EMERGENCY ORDER DEFERRING REQUESTS FOR WRITS OF POSSESSION

**NOW, ON THIS DAY, the Judges of the 6th Judicial Circuit, with the exception of 6th Division, in recognition of the Extraordinary Circumstances occasioned by the advent of the Covid-19 a/k/a 'Novel Coronavirus' Health Emergency, DOTH FIND, ORDER AND ADJUDGE THE FOLLOWING,
To-Wit:**

- 1. As Concerns existing or subsequently filed Petitions for Writs of Possession to Real Property, such Writs SHALL BE DEFERRED AND HELD IN ABEYANCE pending further Orders of the Court.**
- 2. In the interim, parties are free to engage in discovery, or to file pleadings in anticipation of future hearings, or for rulings on dispositive motions following the easing of the Health Crisis.**
- 3. This Emergency Order shall dissolve as soon as is deemed advisable in the interests of Public Safety and upon the further Orders of the Court.**
