



HOSPITAL ADMISSION CHECKLIST

The checklist below is for items needed when being admitted to the hospital. Check each item as it is gathered and completed.

Often, the hospital admission process can be hectic if you do not have the proper information prepared. This checklist of general questions asked during admission and hospital stay, will be helpful. In most cases, it is best to have someone with you that can answer any questions from medical professionals.

A list of any allergies to Medications			
A list of the other allergies

A list of past surgeries, and outpatient procedures <i>(include dates when possible)</i>			
Are you knowledgeable of the family medical history?

This form will help you keep an accurate and current log of medications

The chart is provided as an aid in tracking numerous medications, dosages, and special directions as prescribed by the physicians of the person with a brain injury. Many medications prescribed may have serious side effects, and have special directions.
